The work: all work must be original by the artists. NO commercial work, kits, mass produced items, re-sale, or work done under the supervision of an instructor will be permitted. All work must be for sale and matted and framed in a professional manner. You may sell reproductions of your work appropriately framed or in sleeves.

Right of Refusal: The Guild reserves the right to refuse, at the time of the show, any work that is not presented in an acceptable manner or not representative of the quality of work that was submitted to the jury.

Admission Fees: Public admission to the show is free.

Entry/Space Fee: \$35. The jury fee is \$10, which will be applied to the entry fee of artists accepted. Please make checks payable to the Mountain Home Arts Council. Jury fees will be refunded to accepted artists at the time of the exhibition.

Refund Policy: Any cancellation after October 1 will not be refunded.

Sales: All work must be clearly identified and labeled with the sale price. You will provide your own cash box and sales receipts to the show. A 10% commission will be charged on all sales between \$35 and \$1,000. Artists will not pay commission on any sales over \$1,000. At the close of the show, you must provide a copy of sales to show organizers and pay your commission. A credit card service will be available. Artists who use the service will pay a 4.6% service fee at the time of the sale.

Sales Tax: Artists are responsible to collect and pay Idaho Sales Tax of 6%. If you do not have an Idaho Sales Permit, a temporary one will be provided as part of your registration.

The Space: The venue is a double conference room with approximately 16 - 10X10 display spaces. Artists must provide their own displays and will need to send a photograph of that display if they have not previously participated in this show or have changed their display. Display locations will be assigned by the committee. Please let us know if you have any special needs, including power (which is limited). Chairs and tables and cloths are available. The room is close to the lobby, restrooms, and special catered food and beverage provided by Smoky Mountain Pizza and Pasta. The Visual Artists' Guild is providing a complimentary group room for artists to change or rest during the show.

Jury Process: All artists, including those who have been previously accepted for this show, will be juried this year. Jurors will be Boise area artists Dwight Williams and Zella Bardsley. Work will be juried September 23 and must be received no later than September 20. Please submit 3-5 photos (4x6" size prints) or as a jpg file on a CD. No other media will be accepted. Send a self addressed, stamped envelope if you want your pictures returned. Applications should be mailed to **Sherrie Gregory**, see address below.

Set Up/Break Down: Artists may set up from 9:00 -11:30 a.m. A show packet and space assignments will be given at that time. There is plenty of temporary unloading/loading space close to the show area. Break down begins at 8:00 p.m. No early break down will be permitted.

Accommodations: For out-of-town artists, there are restaurants in the immediate area that serve breakfast, lunch and dinner. There are three hotels in the immediate area for artists who may wish to stay over after the show, as well as other hotels in town and two good RV camping areas.
